You know, olden people, long time ago, they bin walking round everyway. Everyway. Not jealous business. . . not jealous business, not like white people, you know that, not allowed comin' through fence, 'nother place, you know white people.

No jealous for country.

No, olden people they bin walking round, now go back longa 'nother place.

Freer. Its freer. You know why? No fence, no jealous business for country. No.

Freer.
